

## ABOUT THE SCHOOL

The course you are considering has running since 1997 in one form or another. We have called it the Davidic School of Ministry for several good Scriptural reasons:

*David had a heart after God (Acts 13:22). Jesus was the reflection, the very expressed image of the heart of God (Hebrews 1:3).*

*David fulfilled the purposes of God in his generation (Acts 13:36). Christ only did what He saw His father doing (John 5:19).*

*The church is the restoration of the tabernacle of David (Acts 15:16). Jesus said He would build His church (Matthew 16:18).*

*The key of David alone opens doors, and opportunities for the church (Revelation 3:7). Jesus gave us the keys of the kingdom (Matthew 16:19)*

*The throne of David and his kingdom are endless (Isaiah 9:5). This government has been placed upon the shoulders of Jesus Christ (Isaiah 9:6).*

*All authority stems from this seat. "The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ and He shall reign forever" (Revelation 11:15).*

## OUR ETHOS

Davidic School of Ministry is a general school of ministry and theology designed for practical Kingdom outcomes. It is not a traditional Bible college. Our aim was to create a college which would take anybody from ordinary to excellent in one to two years. Our aim is to fulfil Ephesians 4:11-16: leadership gifts raising up a generation who do the work of ministry; to have as our scope going into all the world (Matthew 28:19), and making disciples who make disciples (2 Timothy 2:2).

## WHAT WE ASSUME

To undertake this course, we assume:

*A basic biblical knowledge, that is, you have read the Bible at least once right through.*

*A basic education up to grade ten.*

*The ability to read English and complete a text book for each stream.*

## WHERE IS THE COURSE?

The Davidic School of Ministry is offered as :

- A part time course by distance education, doing one life stream at a time.
- As a series of weekend intensives, run in one location (hosted by a church or group).
- A three semester, eighteen month, full time course face to face.

450 hours of study require reading a text for each stream, doing assignments, group exercises and fulfilling practical projects. It also includes doing 4 one-week intensives.

The school has been run in India, the Philippines, South Africa, Australia and Zimbabwe.
